Item 5. Chief MacDonald noted that the SCBA compressor acquired as a result of the AFG grant has been installed.

Item 6. The DES Project is installed and complete.

Item 7. Chief Macdonald noted that Brian Dubreuil has recently acquired two grants. The first was a federal COVID related grant to help offset NBFD costs for the PPE for our EMT's at \$15,400. The second grant was a State department of Justice Grant for decon equipment for our vehicles and facilities valued at \$6,500.
