6. The undersigned hereby demonstrates that the lawful construction or alteration of a building or structure, a parking lot or way, including a driveway, are the principal activities on the property on which this excavation is being requested by providing the following information:
 - a. the nature and volume of lawful construction or alteration of a building or structure, a parking lot or way including a driveway, that are proposed to be constructed on the site;

 - b. the contemplated amount of material that is intended to be removed;



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- c. the extent to which and manner in which the proposed excavation is related to or required in order to facilitate the lawful construction or alteration of a building or structure, a parking lot or way including a driveway, that is contemplated on the property;

- d. the contemplated duration of the removal operation;

- e. the following specific information regarding the proposed excavation operation:

- (i) The name and address of the owner of the land to be excavated;

- (ii) The name and address of the person who will actually do the excavating;

- (iii) The names and addresses of all abutters to the premises, which will be excavated;

- (iv) A plan at a scale of no less than one inch equals one hundred feet (1" = 100'), which would comply with Erosion and Sedimentation Control provisions of the Town of New Boston Subdivision Regulations and would be of a quality that is easily understood and of an accuracy that compliance can easily be checked or, if permitted by the Regulator, in lieu thereof, a copy of the existing subdivision plan or other similar document that contains with reasonable accuracy, the information as listed in Appendix 1, Section III, B, 2, b, (v), of the New Boston Earth Removal Regulations;



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7. I/We have read the Town of New Boston Earth Removal Regulations, and agree to be bound by them and all applicable State, Federal, and Local laws and regulations. I/We understand that failure to comply with this agreement or the applicable regulations, ordinances, and laws may result in revocation of or denial of approvals or permits by the Town.
8. I/We understand that the Office of the Planning Board/Planning Department must have on file a completed application with all required submissions as outlined in the Earth Removal Regulations at least 15 days prior to a scheduled public meeting of the Regulator.
9. I/We understand that the Regulator or its designee may make periodic inspections, minimally on an annual basis, of all excavation sites, both permitted and exempt, to determine if the operations are in conformance with these regulations and the approved plans.

I/We am/are requesting that the application be scheduled for a public hearing by the Planning Board within thirty (30) days from the receipt date.
