There is a new member who is interested 74 in joining the Energy Commission. 75 76 It was previously decided that all members would be present for the Fire Department Budget 77 discussion. 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Kary Jencks reviewed her report. She has spent time facilitating the last Department Head meeting and putting into process the format for Town Administrator candidate selection. The end of application submission for this round will be on August 4th. There are 13 candidates at this time. Three additional community members and a facilitator will be sought to serve on the selection committee. Once the positions are filled, a calendar for the interview process will be created. The Board can submit its own questions to Maralyn Segien for inclusion. There will be a vetting process with the committee and NHMA to reduce the number from 13.

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Donna Mombourquette noted that the Town received information regarding the lawsuit between PSNH and the Town regarding evaluation of utility poles. The Superior Court stay has been lifted and people will need to testify on behalf of the municipality. Bill McFadden suggested getting an update on this topic from the Town's attorney.

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Donna Mombourquette noted that Jackson Barnes has earned the rank of Eagle Scout. The Board agreed to draft a letter of congratulations and ask him if he would like to attend the next Board meeting.
